**Care and maintenance of your clasp**

Your clasp was checked, and oiled after assembly. If by chance you put your ring into dish detergent, you should re-oil the joints. A tiny drop of any tool oil will do. 3-in-one oil or sewing machine oil is good.

Just wipe off the excess with a tissue.

At least once a year, clean your ring with Windex and oil the joints.

Beware that clapping with rings on both hands  
damages all kinds of rings

**How to check for wear.**

Note how tight the joints are on your new clasp, and how firm the nose of the latch is. By gently trying to jiggle the hinge, and the latch, you will see if any looseness is developing. Usually service is not required before 5 or 6 years of normal use. If you take care of your clasp, you could delay service longer. Remember that all moving parts will wear with time; so take good care of your clasp.

**Knowing how to use your P.F.F. clasp**

When closing the clasp on your finger,  
keep it rotating in slow motion as you  
continue to close the clasp,

This will avoid pinching skin  
between the closing parts

**When using the (D.S.) Deluxe**

Always put your finger into the bottom half  
first, then close the top part of the ring to  
lock it on the finger.

**This will avoid any pinching of the skin  
with the hinge spring (D. S.)**
